

CEG - 33 CADOGAN STREET, GLASGOW

Following feedback from the initial ActiveScore assessment, CEG implemented design changes such as more diverse and more secure bike parking. These upgrades contributed to 33 Cadogan Street becoming the highest-rated ActiveScore building in Scotland.






VORNADO - THE FARLEY BUILDING, NEW YORK

Originally completed in 1914, the Farley building was home to New York's main USPS (United States Postal Service) branch for nearly a century. More recently Vornado have restored the building, with Meta as the main tenant. Preserving existing architecture and ambitious infrastructure design (LEED Gold, ActiveScore Gold) are two ESG strategies that mitigate emissions and enhance the occupier experience.




It's inspiring to see our AP community growing rapidly around the world. The first six months of 2023 outpaced the same period in 2022 by 347%, and Q2 2023 was our busiest quarter yet.

This quarter saw our first APs in Japan, Pakistan, Argentina and Barbados. In Europe, we welcomed APs from Austria, Denmark and Romania, while a little closer to home we had our first APs in Wales and the Isle of Man.

With 860 APs worldwide in 42 countries, we are poised to enter new markets faster with the help of our evergrowing AP network. Many members of the community are sustainability and environmental consultants, which aligns with our mission to make cities more liveable places.

Alignments

ActiveScore is aligned with other market-leading green building certifications – our accreditation can help towards the achievement of WELL and GRESB.

WELL

As of Q2, WELL (International WELL Building Institute IWBI) Certifications and ActiveScore Ratings are now aligned to support occupier well-being. Complementary guidance from ActiveScore and the IWBI will ultimately result in better buildings.

Since building standards contain criteria that affect multiple assessments, alignments like this one allow building owners to streamline certification, and earn points towards ratings simultaneously.

ActiveScore Gold or above supports the WELL Movement concept, one of the 10 WELL concepts in the WELL Building Standard.

WELL projects that achieve an ActiveScore Gold award in their certification are awarded full marks [3 points] for Feature V04: Facilities for Active Occupants:

Part 1: Provide Cycling Infrastructure at Tier 2

Part 2: Provide Showers, Lockers And Changing Facilities
